

QualityMetric Co-founder Accepts Research Professor Position at UMass Medical School

John E. Ware, Jr., PhD, QualityMetric Incorporated co-founder and Chief Science Officer, is leaving the company. He was recently named Research Professor and Chief, Outcomes Measurement Research Division in the new Department of Quantitative Health Sciences at the University of Massachusetts Medical School.

Ware co-founded QualityMetric Incorporated in 1997, after serving for 12 years as Senior Scientist at The Health Institute at the New England Medical Center (NEMC) in Boston, and Principal Investigator for the Medical Outcomes Study. It was during this time that he created the SF-36[®] Health Survey and other tools widely used to monitor health outcomes. Before moving to NEMC, Ware spent 13 years as a Senior Research Psychologist at the RAND Corporation. An internationally recognized expert in health outcomes assessment, Ware is also a member of the Institute of Medicine, National Academy of Sciences.
